Instruction

School resumes August 17th for K-12 and 19th for PK

All instruction will be face-to-face

Parents may choose to keep student at home with remote learning

Adjustments to schedules for Elementary Specials

Teachers will use Canvas as a Learning Management System for individual/cohort remote learning

Ongoing training for teachers in Canvas, Scoot Pad, and digital components of current programs.

Daily Arrival

Main Entrance—temp and health screening
Building open at 7:45am for students
Staff with children—teacher room only
Buses unload one at a time
Students "grab 'n go" Breakfast

No hallway gatherings—students report to homerooms

Main Office & Visitors

Restricted use of Main Office for all staff Use drop box or email to submit paperwork, request supplies, etc.

Use hallway entrance to superintendent's office

Visitors wear masks on entry

Visitors sign in and provide contact phone number

Meetings follow 6-foot SD guidelines, masking as needed

Phone conference/Zoom whenever possible

Meeting leaders keep list of participants

Social Distancing and Masking Requirements

Classrooms arranged to accommodate 6-foot social distancing (SD) when possible.

Assigned seats and seating charts kept up-to-date.

Shields in place when 6-foot SD is not possible

Visual reminders to maintain 6-foot SD throughout school

Elementary students stay in cohort groups. Some classes split for Art to maintain 6-foot SD.

Recess by cohort only. Elementary teachers will determine recess times and remain with cohort group to supervise.

Lockers assigned for students in grades 6-12

Masks worn when 6-foot SD is not possible and/or lasts for more than 15 minutes; during hallway passing (6-12); on school vehicles; at the request of teacher or administrator.

Students have the option to wear their own (school appropriate) mask or a mask provided by the school.

Staff/students may choose to mask all day.

Hand Washing and Disinfecting

Elementary students: wash hands or use hand sanitizer every hour, before & after recess Middle/High School students: Use hand sanitizer at beginning of class

EVERYONE before & after meals & snacks, after using the restrooms, after blowing nose, sneezing, or coughing

Sanitation Stations available throughout the building—use often!

Avoid sharing supplies; sanitize as needed

Students use individually assigned devices: K-1—iPads, 2-5—Chromebooks, 6-12—Laptops

Teachers bring and pick-up students from specials to allow for inter-cohort cleaning & disinfecting

Bathrooms cleaned every hour during regular school day

Hard surfaces in classrooms disinfected as frequently as possible

Students can use "student safe" disinfecting wipes/solution to help w/parent permission

Parents

Keep your child at home if s/he is experiencing any of the following symptoms: Fever >100.4°F, cough, shortness of breath, runny nose, difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea Follow-up with family physician Call Panhandle Public Health at 308-262-5764 Keep your child home if any member of your household has tested positive for COVID-19 Update Emergency Contact information in the Parent Portal

Bus Transportation

Temp and health screening at pick-up point Sanitize hands at boarding

First on—last off

Assigned seats—family groups together

Wear masks while on bus

Maintain social distance while waiting at town stops

Buses unload one at a time at school—at 7:45am

Buses sanitized daily after morning routes

Dismissal— bus students mask and proceed to buses; walkers wait in the Library and maintain 6-foot SD until dismissed

Option Enrichment Fridays

Group limits for all sessions will be in place to maintain SD Students stay in selected session—no switching between sessions Sharing of materials and supplies restricted when possible Hand washing at the beginning of each session; before & after lunch; after using the restrooms, after blowing nose, sneezing, or coughing

Breakfast, Lunch, Snack, & Water

Wash/sanitize hands before eating

Breakfast served as "Grab 'n go" - eaten in homeroom

Lunch seating split between cafeteria and small gym as assigned

Classes staggered to line up for lunch as scheduled to maintain SD

Social distance maintained in line and at tables

4 lunch periods: K-2@11:00; 3-5@11:30; 6-8@12:03; 9-12@12:33

No salad bar

Classroom "family style meal" or snacks served by teacher

Meal count recorded via bar code scanner—no touch pad available

"Seconds" recorded by line servers

Students in 6-12 attend Wildcat Pride period before/after scheduled lunchtime

All students remain in cafeteria/gym until dismissed or collected by teacher

Wash/sanitize hands after eating

Monitors assigned to both cafeteria & hallways

No drinking from water fountains

Students may refill water bottles at the fountains
