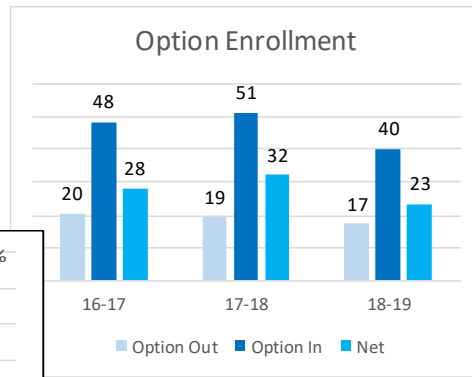

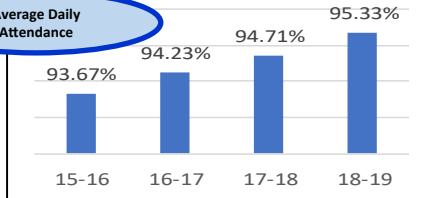


Student Academic Growth AQuESTT Classification 2017-2018

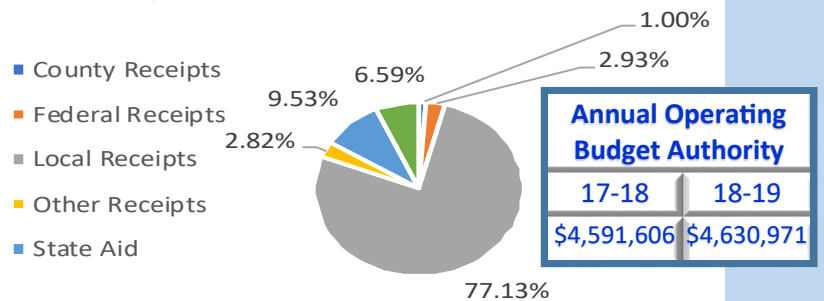
Cooperative agreements with Leyton (HS football) and Gering (girls' soccer) are in effect.

Annual Operating Budget Authority

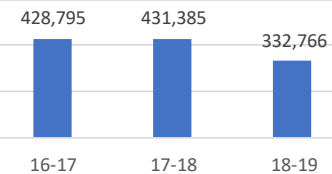
